Tracked **60+ community indicators**, with more than one-third disaggregated by race



Released the **Guide to Strengthening Crisis Response, Relief, and Recovery** following the Winter Storms



Relaunched our **COVID-19 Dashboard**, tracking local cases, deaths & milestones from the beginning of the crisis



Released the **Community Engagement Report and Toolkit** sharing takeaways from our 2020 yearlong engagement process to co-create the shared vision

Launched **ILoveSanAntonio.org** for the municipal election, hosting **11,000+ visitors** in 2021

Trained & matched **84 people with 36 nonprofit boards** through **The Board Game**



Collaborated with USAA to strengthen their local **philanthropic giving for racial equity**

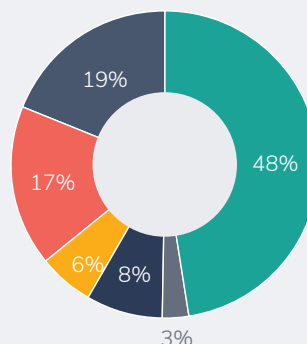
